On **Friday, April 11, 2025, at 10:30 a.m.**, the Kent County Director of Planning, Housing, and Zoning will hold a public hearing in the County Commissioners' Hearing Room, 400 High Street, Chestertown, Maryland. James and Michelle Genovese are requesting an administrative special exception to construct a 676-square foot pole building with a 572-square foot second-floor apartment that will also exceed the median height limit of 17 feet on a property less than 5 acres. The property is located at 26047 Bessicks Corner Road, Still Pond, in the Second Election District, and is zoned Agricultural Zoning District (AZD).
